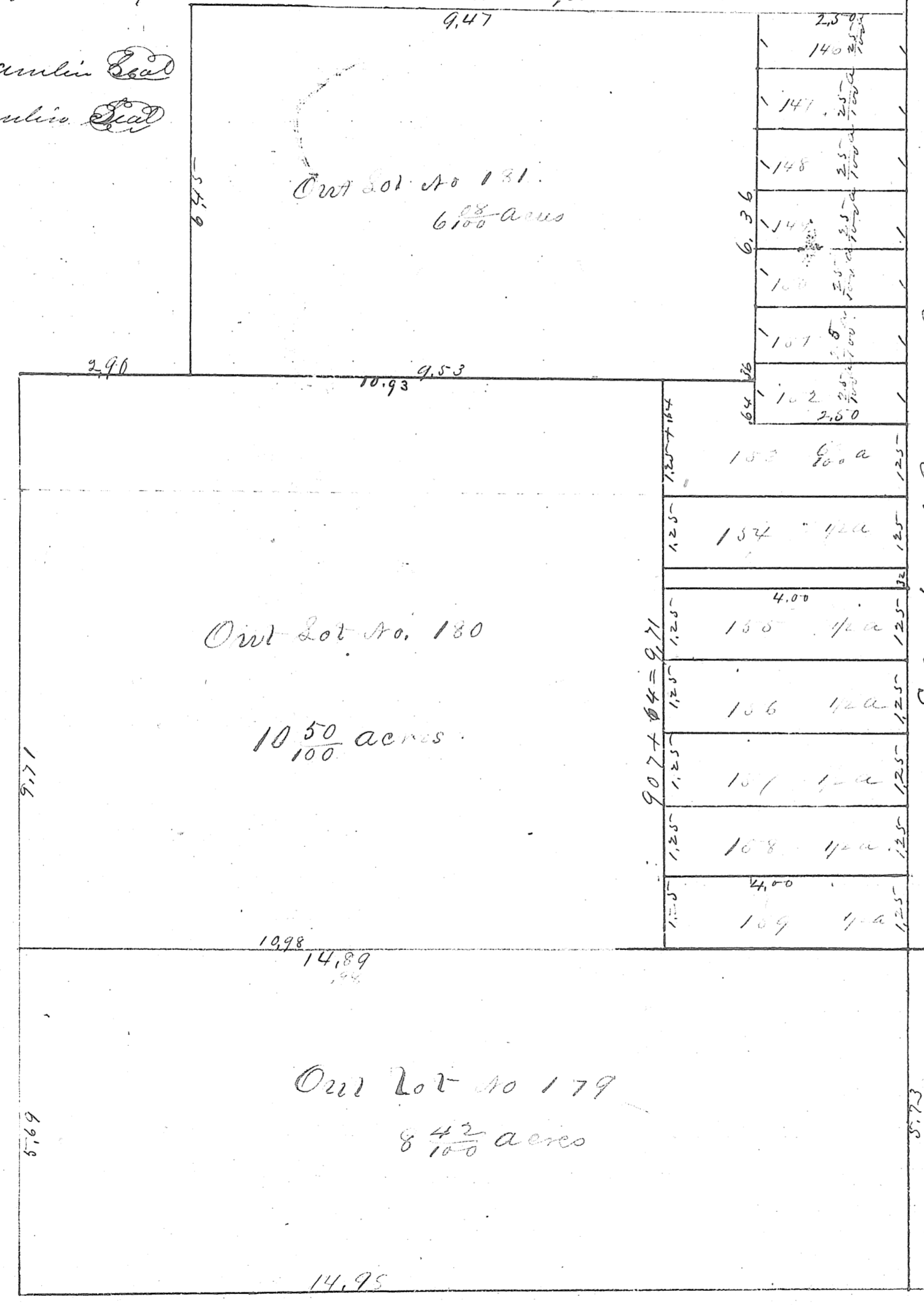


I hereby certify that at the instance of J. M. Hamlin I on the seventh day of September 1868 surveyed the land represented in the accompanying plat beginning 8 Ch 76 links north of the South line of Lot No 27 in the west margin of Main Street in the village of Wellington and near the South East Corner of said Lot No 27. Hence Laying off lots as by accompanying plat. I also laid out a Street 91 lks wide 577 Ch North of the said S. E. Corner. thence west until it meets an extension of Prospect Street, Also laid out 91 links in width; distances are marked in chains and links. The quantities are given in acres and decimals, the lot or an number in red ink from No 146 to 181 the scaling the plat is 2 Chains to one inch or 1/324 part of the Real size.
