" Minutes on the back of the original Map of the Village of Elyria.

" Plan of the survey of the Town plot in Elyria Lorain County Ohio as surveyed by Joshua Henshaw in the year 1823.

All the Streets and Alleys except Broad Street as it is now open - Pine Street - Cedar Street south of Broad Street - Mill Street - West Bridge Street - East Bridge Street - West road - Middle or State Road and East road are reserved to be used and occupied by the Proprietor his heirs and assigns as follows, viz: North Street east of Pine and west of Mill Streets, and Cedar Street north of Coopers Alley ten yards, North Street between Mill + Pine Streets, Chestnut Street north of South Street, Spruce Street, South Street between West Road and Cedar Street and Wests alley five yards, and all the cross streets and alleys south of South Street for the term of fifteen years. Broad Street is six rods in width, all the other streets are four and all the alleys are two rods in width.

The Blocks marked alphabetically A. to C. inclusive remain to be allotted as well as the ground north of North Street. Reserving also for the term of five years free from taxation all Town Lots all except those included between Pine and Spruce, and North and South Streets. The Lot marked C.H. having been heretofore conveyed to Edmund West in trust for the County of Lorain for the erection of County buildings, and the Public Square; and Lot number 129. for the erection of an Academy or Seminary of learning; and Lot number 133. for the erection of a Meeting House, according to the conditions specified in Deed of said West and recorded in Brown and Lorain Counties - reference being had to said deeds. The Lots on the within plan as designated by numbers in red ink contain as follows, viz:

Nos. 128. to 131. are four rods wide and eight rods in length.

" 132. + 134. are three rods in width and eight rods in depth.

" 133. is six rods in width and eight rods in depth.

" 115. 168. 97. + 182. are about three rods in width by ten rods in depth.

" 103 + 105. are 14 rods in width by 20 rods in depth.

Lots " 26. 29. 33. 52. + 222. each contain seventeen hundredths of an acre.

The Blocks of this Plot are recorded in Lorain County Records Book B. page 400. + 401. the Blocks only are there numbered, and some deeds have been made by me according to those numbers.

The Town of Elyria being now incorporated this plot is recorded with the allotment of the blocks as surveyed into Town lots and numbered accordingly.

No part of the land is to be considered as now surveyed into Town lots and subject to Corporation taxes except such as is designated in the eighteenth section of the Act of Incorporation. The lots designated in said 18 section viz: No. 89. is within Plot No. 103. Lot No. 79. is now No. 226. the north part of Lot No. 52. is now 239. + South part of No. 238. " W. Latrop's lot " is now numbered 236. and Chinego Johnson's lot. is that marked P. J.

The contents of lots No. 37. + 38. are reduced by straightening Water Street and most of Lot No. 201. + part of No. 202. are cut off by the alteration of North Street as shown by black dotted line. Mill Street is not to extend further north than the line drawn across it being eighteen rods from the north line of Broad Street.

That part of North Street cut off by this alteration is vacated. Lodi Street extends from North Street to the West falls Bridge + is four rods wide.

The points and figures along the branches of the River denote the survey of their courses + distances made by Joshua Henshaw in October 1816.

The above memoranda made by me this 21st day of June 1833. is to be taken as a part of this Instrument. Henshaw Ely.

The enlargement of the Public Square extending south to the south line of Third Street is shown by black dotted line + the alley between Blocks B. + C. and so much of Chestnut and Third Streets as adjoins said Blocks are to be considered as vacated.
