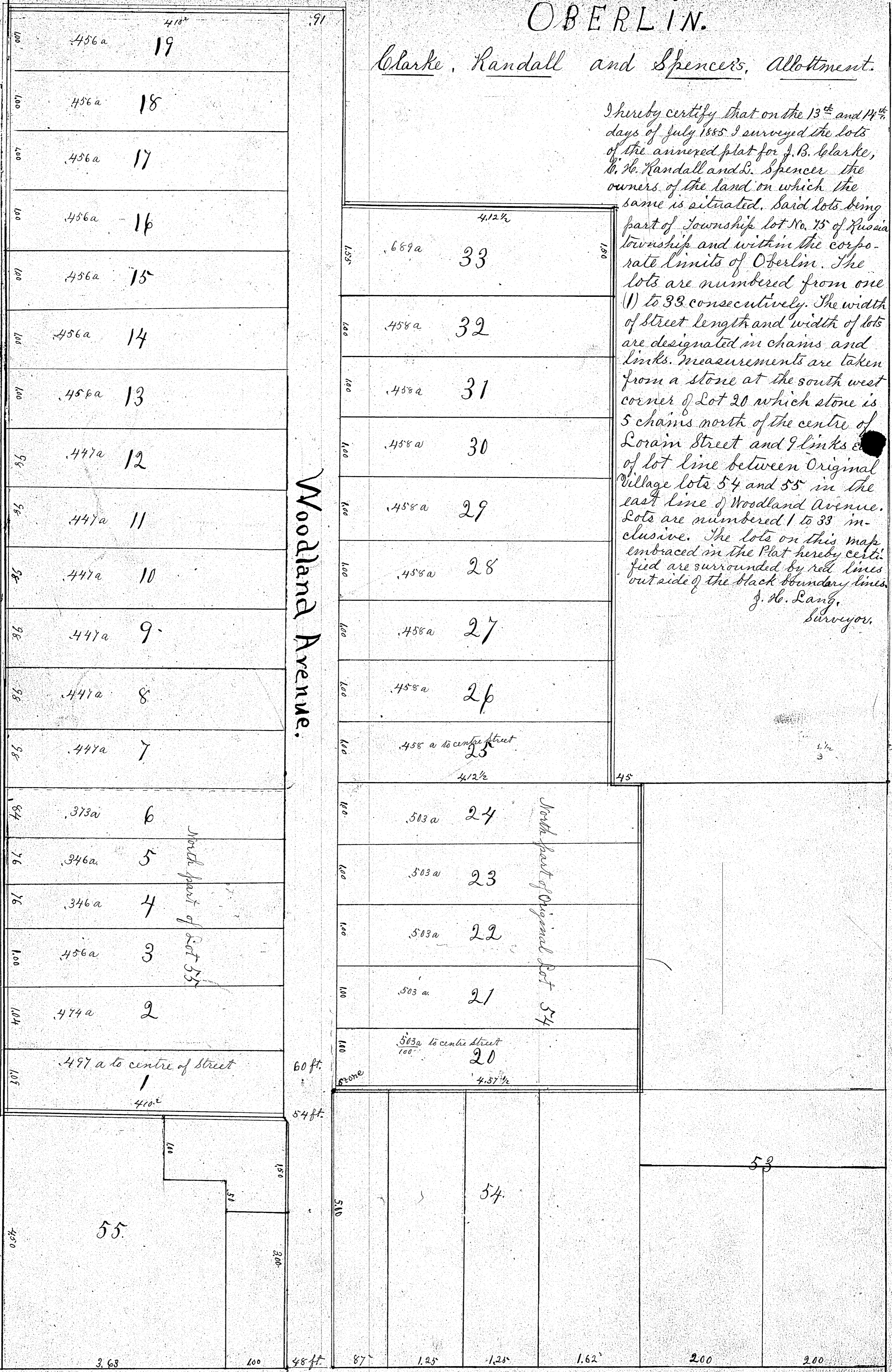

Clarke, Randall and Spencers, Allotment.

I hereby certify that on the 13th and 14th
 days of July 1885 I surveyed the lots
 of the annexed plat for J. B. Clarke,
 Chas. H. Randall and L. Spencer the
 owners of the land on which the
 same is situated. Said lots being
 part of Township lot No. 75 of Russia
 Township and within the corpo-
 rate limits of Oberlin. The
 lots are numbered from one
 (1) to 33 consecutively. The width
 of street length and width of lots
 are designated in chains and
 links. Measurements are taken
 from a stone at the south west
 corner of Lot 20 which stone is
 5 chains north of the centre of
 Lorain Street and 9 links
 of lot line between Original
 Village lots 54 and 55 in the
 east line of Woodland Avenue.
 Lots are numbered 1 to 33 in-
 clusive. The lots on this map
