Kuang's Addition - To - The Village of Lorain

This Addition made at the request of Conrad Krang is a part of original Block
 River Lots, being 6 2/3 acres in Lot 5, and is shown by
 the colored parts of the above maps. It is a part of the land decided by A. R. Fitzgerald to Conrad Krang
 by deed recorded in Vol. 9 at page 386 Lorain Co. Records, and part of the land decided by Shalch Hawley to Conrad Krang
 by deed recorded in Vol. 9 at page 386 Lorain Co. Records. The part west of the center of Hamilton Street as shown on this map is bounded westerly
 by Oklaw Avenue, northwesterly by the south line of the original Plat of Charleston easterly by the center of Hamilton Street, southerly by lines as
 shown on the above maps. The part east of the center line of Hamilton Street is bounded northerly by the prolongation of the south line of Polk Street
 as shown on the above maps by the Union School Grounds which are described by proceeding recorded in Vol. 1, Paul-road appropriations at page 557
 Lorain Co. Records easterly by said Union School Grounds by Washington Street, southerly by lands decided by Conrad Krang - 70 - Tyler, et al., by deed recorded
 in Vol. 36 at page 133, Lorain Co. Records, westerly by Center line of Hamilton Street, Washington St. Oklaw Avenue, Polk St. from Oklaw Ave.
 to the East line of the Cemetery, as now Public Highways, Hamilton Street, Woodline Street, Polk Street from the east side of the Cemetery
 to Hamilton Street as to be hereby dedicated for public use. Hamilton Street extends from the south line of the Original Plat of
 Charleston to the south line of this Addition, as shown on the above map. The colored part only is to be hereby dedicated.
 Woodline Street is 60 feet wide, and extends from Washington Street to Hamilton Street. Polk Street is 66 feet wide, and the part
 to be dedicated extends from the east side of the Cemetery to Hamilton Street. The center line of Polk Street is parallel with and 396 feet
 south of the center line of Washington Street. The number of the south line of the south line of the respective center
 Distances are given on the respective lines in feet and decimals. Stone monuments are placed at all points marked here.
 The corners are given to a meridian intending to describe the angle only. All of which I certify to be correct
