



The annexed plat and survey of C. A. Sturtevant's Fair Home Allotment was made at said Sturtevant's request and consists of the former Ebenezer Gregg farm in the Village of Lorain, County of Lorain State of Ohio and contains about 90 acres of land, bounded as follows: On the North by Erie Avenue; J. D. Lawler trustee and C. F. Hageman et al subdivisions; On the West by the River Road, Mrs. E. Gregg's and O. F. Hageman et al Subdivisions and D. Garris land; On the South by the N. O. C. and St. L. R.R. and on the East by the East line of said Gregg farm. The scale of the map is 100 feet per inch, the dimensions are noted in feet and decimal parts thereof. Stone monuments were set at points indicated and Iron Rods were found at points noted. All of which I certify to be correct.
