

WORTHY S. STREATOR TR ADDITION

The Land included in this Addition, is part of Original Lot No. 93 Sheffield Township, now in the Village of Lorain, and is bounded as follows: On the East, by the Westerly line of the right of way of the Cleveland, Lorain and Wheeling Railroad; on the West, by the original line between Sheffield and Black River Townships; on the South by Globeville Road; and on the North By a line 144 feet distant from the North line of Globeville Road and Parallel thereto.
