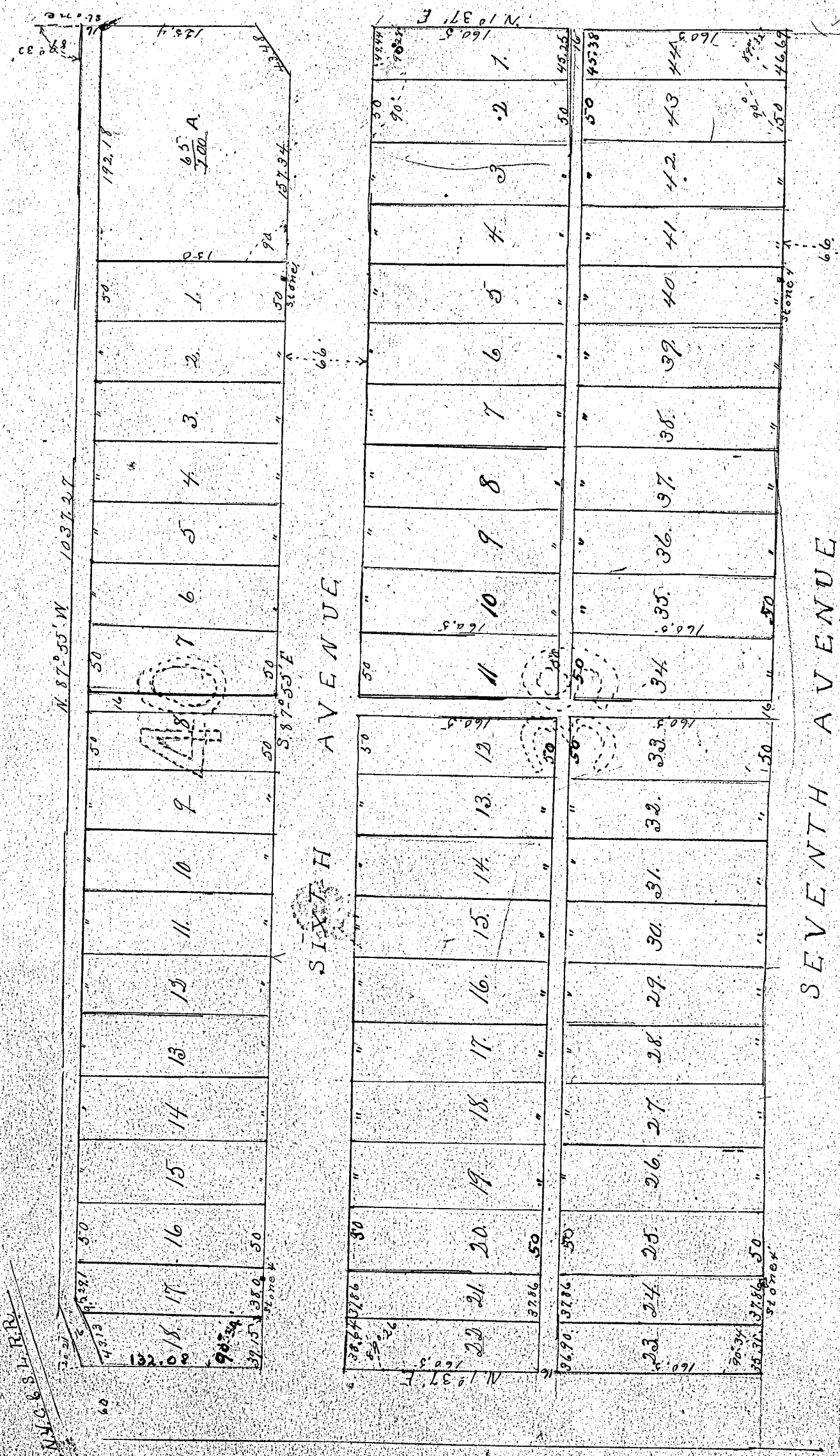


# SUBDIVISION OF PARTS OF BLOCKS

## 34-35-39 AND 40

### CHAMBERLAIN'S ADDITION.



Surveyed March 23<sup>rd</sup> 1893 for N.S. Steward Trustee, the following numbered lots in Block 34 Chamberlain's Add. to Lorain, Lorain Co. Ohio, viz: numbers 1 to 21 inclusive with a front of Block 35 sufficient for the extension of Clark St. 66 ft. wide to Long St. Also lots 1 to 24 inclusive in Block 39 of the same addition, also lots 1 to 18 inclusive in Block 40 of the same addition.

The dimensions of lots and width of streets and alleys are as shown on the plat. The stone monuments 6" x 6" x 80 are placed as shown on the plat. For Block 34: One on the front line of lot 17 and 4 ft. from the north east corner of the same; One on the front line of lot 18 and 4 ft. from the south east corner of the same; One on the front line of lot 19 at the intersection of the northern line of Clark Ave. and Clark St. One on the east line of Long St. at the north east corner of lot 23. For Block 39: One on the front line of lot 24 and 4 ft. from the south east corner of the same; One on the front line of lot 25 and 4 ft. from the south east corner of the same. For Block 40: One on the west line of Long St. on the south line of the 16' Alley running back of lots 1-18. One on the front line of lot 17 and 4 ft. from the south east corner of the same. 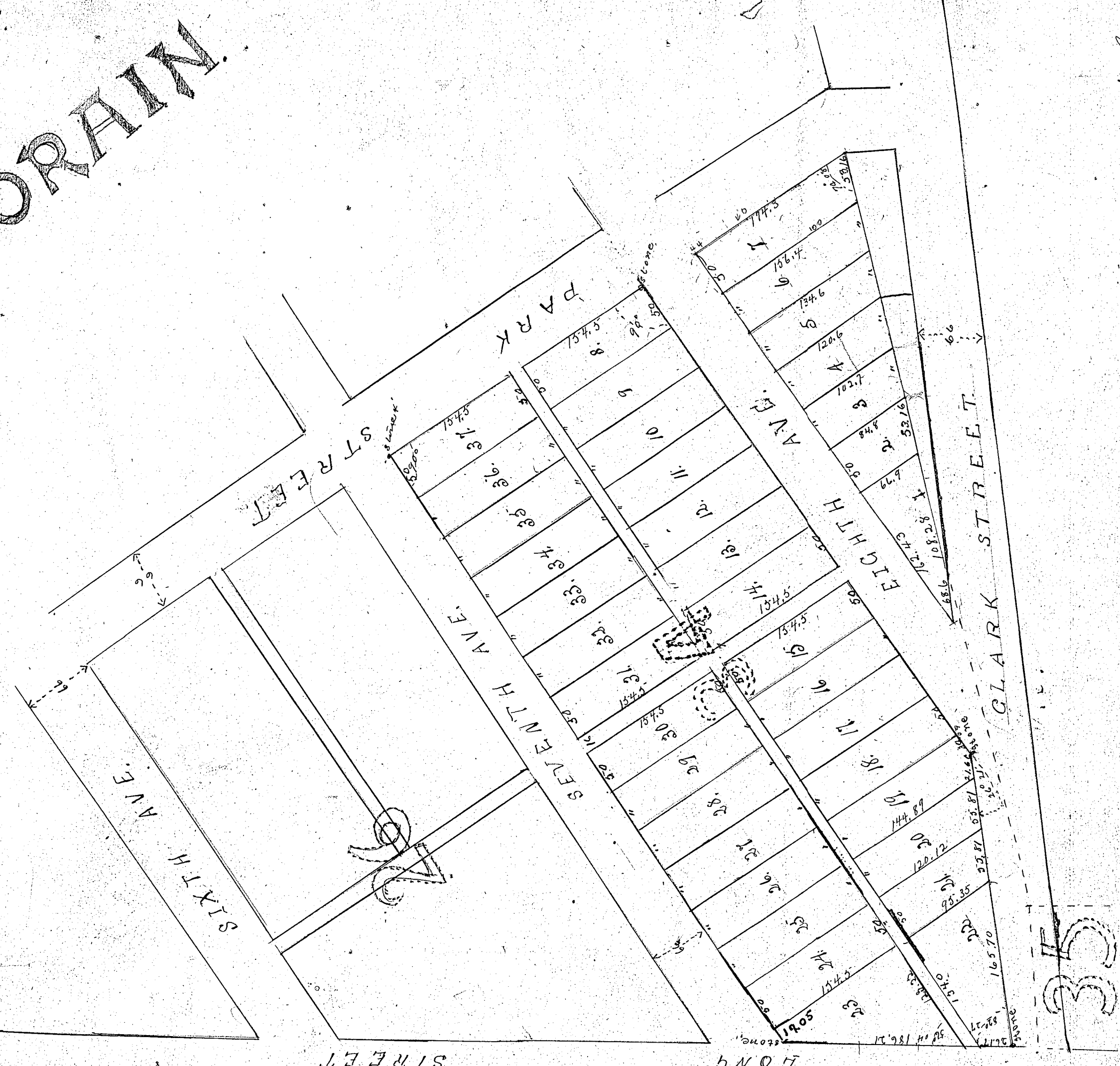
