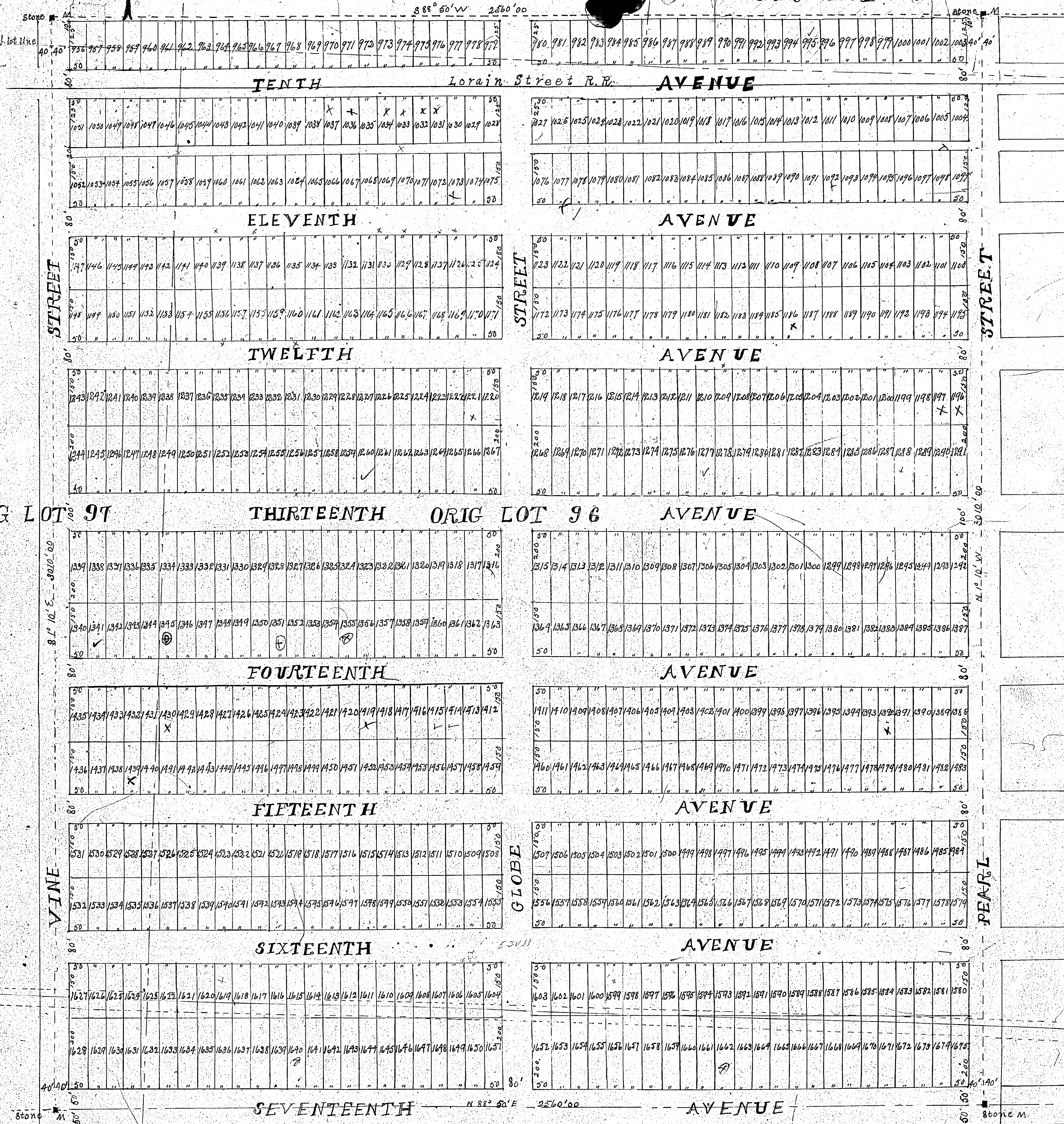

Subdivision No 2 of the Sheffield Land Company's Addition to the Village of Lorain, Lorain County, Ohio, being a portion of the Original Sheffield Township Lots Nos. 88, 89, 90, 96, 97, 101, and 102 is bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument at the Northwest corner of Subdivision No 1, of the Sheffield Land Company's Addition to the Village of Lorain, measuring thence S 88° 50' W 2560.0 feet on a line parallel with the center line of South Ave. and 175 feet distant therefrom to a stone monument in the center of Vine St. Thence S 1° 10' E 3010 feet along the center line of Vine St. to a stone monument at the intersection of the center line of Vine St. and the center line of Seventh Ave. Thence N 88° 50' W 2560.0 feet to a stone monument at the intersection of the center line of Seventh Ave. and the center line of Pearl St. Thence N 1° 10' W 3010.0 feet along the center line of Pearl St. to the point or place of beginning. The Sheffield Land Company and its successors reserve the perpetual right to lay and maintain street car lines, sewers, water and other pipes, and to place electric wires and poles along the center of the streets. The streets being subject to the rights granted by the Sheffield Land Company to the Lorain Street Railway Company by deed given.
