



H. O. WOOD'S ADDITION

TO THE VILLAGE OF LORAIN OHIO.

This Addition of $4\frac{146}{1000}$ Acres, made at the request of H. O. Wood is situated in original Lot No. 3 Tract No. 1 Black River Township now in the Village of Lorain and is bounded North by the South line of the Lorain Stone Company's 1st. subdivision; South by a line parallel with said North line and 362 feet therefrom; East by the West line of Granger Street; and West by a line 30 feet West of the East line of Oakdale Boulevard and parallel therewith. Oakdale Boulevard and Granger Street are already established. Hoyt Street and Alton Street are continuations of same streets in the Brass Company's Addition. Hoyt street, the South 34 feet of Alton Street and the East 30 feet of Oakdale Boulevard are to be hereby dedicated to public use. Measurements are given in feet and decimals thereof, stone monuments were found or placed at all points so marked on the Plat. All of which I hereby certify to be correct. E. C. Loofbourrow Surveyor.

We the undersigned owners of the land embraced in this Addition hereby adopt this plat of the same and dedicate to public use Hoyt street the South 34 feet of Alton street and the east 30 feet of Oakdale Boulevard.
