

## Engineers Certificate.

This is to certify, that the undersigned has surveyed and set iron stakes monuments at all points indicated thus, on the accompanying map; located correctly the buildings shown thereon; that no encroachments exist; description of the land embraced by the accompanying survey map, to wit: Description: Parcel No. 1: Situated in the Township of Elyria, City of Elyria, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, and being parts of Original Lots No. 12-13 and 14, West of Black River, in said Township, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a stone monument at the Northwesterly corner of said Original Lot 13 and on the Southerly line of West Street, called; thence along the Northerly line of said Lot 13, South 89° 24' 30" East, a distance of 661.81 feet, to an iron pin; thence continuing along the Southwesterly line of the right of way of The New York Central Railroad Company, South 69° 28' 30" East, a distance of 536.0 feet, to an iron pin on the Easterly line of said Railroad right of way; and 133 feet by rectangular measurement Southerly from the original centerline of said right of way, South 73° 14' 30" East, a distance of 73' 14' 30" East, a distance of 1620.54 feet, to an iron pin, on the Easterly line of said Lot 12; thence along the Easterly line of said right of way, last described, South to Edwin J. Powell, by deed dated January 6, 1915, and recorded in Volume 125, Page 50, of Lorain County Records of Deeds, North 1° 14' 30" West, a distance of 2882.02 feet, to an iron pin, at the Southeast corner of said to Edwin J. Powell, as aforesaid, N 89° 45' West, a distance of 189.92 feet, to an iron pin on the Easterly line of premises in said Lot 12 as deeded a distance of 1300.53 feet, to an iron pin; thence along the Westerly line of premises in said Lot 13, as deeded to Aloysius Schuster and Rose Schuster, by deed dated May 16, 1945, and recorded in Volume 351, Page 450, of Lorain County Record of Deeds, South 89° 53' West, a distance of 1559.10 feet, to an iron pin on the Westerly line of said Lot 13; thence along the Westerly line of said Lot 13, North 1° 15' East, a distance of 323.65 feet, to an iron pin; thence along the Southwesterly line of premises in said Lot 14, as deeded to Johanna Wierch, by deed, Volume 280, Page 27, of Lorain County Record of Deeds, N 89° 26' 30" West, and passing through an iron pin on the Easterly line of Murray Ridge Road, a distance of 1514.93 feet, to the center of said road; thence in the center of Murray Ridge Road, North 19° 40' West, a distance of 291.45 feet, thence along the Northerly line of premises as deeded to Johanna Wierch, as aforesaid, South 89° 26' 30" East, and passing through an iron pin found on the Easterly line of Murray Ridge Road, a distance of 1617.17 feet, to an iron pin on the Easterly line of said Lot 14; thence along the Easterly line of said Lot 14, and Westerly line of said Lot 13, North 1° 15' East, a distance of 1134.80 feet, to the place of beginning. Containing within said bounds a total of 2.74.11 acres of land, of which Lot 12 are 102.985 Acres; in Lot 13 are 61.293 Acres; and in Lot 14, are 9.833 Acres.

Parcel No. 2: Situated in the Township, City, County and State aforesaid, and being a part of Original Lot 12, West of Black River, in said Township, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the Northerly line of said Lot 12 and on the Southwesterly line of West Street, from a stone monument at the Northeast corner of said Lot; thence along the Northerly line of said Lot and Southwesterly line of said West Street, a distance of 338.0 feet, as measured along the Northerly line of said Lot and Southwesterly line of said West Street, from a stone monument at the Northeast corner of to an iron pin; thence along the Easterly line of premises in said Lot 12 as deeded to Aloysius Schuster and Rose Schuster, by deed dated May 17, 1944, and recorded in Volume 336, Page 26, of Lorain County Record of Deeds, South 1° 36' 30" West, a distance of 316.21 feet, to an iron pin; thence along the Northerly line of the right of way of The New York Central Railroad, and 68 feet by rectangular measurement, Northerly from the original centerline of said railroad right of way, South 73° 14' 30" East, a distance of 351.0 feet, to an iron pin; thence North 1° 36' 30" East, parallel with the Westerly line of premises herein described, said Lot 12, as deeded to the Industrial Brown Hoist Corp., by deed dated Oct. 26, 1927, and recorded in Volume 229, Page 347 of Lorain County Record of Deeds, a distance of 323.96 feet, to the place of beginning. Containing within said bounds 0.249 Acres of land.
