BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorgin, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the permanent improvements, including water and sewer lines, streets, and street lights, for Phase II Oberlin Reserve Subdivision as recorded in Vol. 74, Pages 37-39, of the Lorain County Record of Plats, be and the same are hereby accepted by the City of Oberlin for ownership, operation, and maintenance pursuant to Section 1311.06 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for he preservation of public peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to allow for the provision of public health and safety services to persons living within the subdivision", and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
