WHEREAS, a petition and map for annexation of 11.1324 acres from Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin were filed with the Clerk of Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio on October 7, 2005 by Attorney Jon D. Clark, Agent for the petitioner; Land Concepts Co., Inc., - Richard E. Nord; and

WHEREAS, the petition, map and description was forwarded to the Engineer and Auditor for their reviews; and

WHEREAS, Ken Carney, Lorain County Engineer by letter dated October 19, 2005 submitted the following:

"We have reviewed the description and map for the proposed Annexation of 11.1324 acres of land in Original Lot #26 of Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin, Ohio.

Jon D. Clark is acting Agent for the only Petitioner, Land Concepts Co., Inc.
The description follows the map and both appear to the correct. The Parcel is adjacent to and contiguous with the City of Oberlin.

The previous annexation of properties on the north side of U.S. 20 extended to the north right-of-way line of U.S. 20. This proposed annexation as well as the previous annexation of Permanent Parcel#14-00-026-000-009 immediately to the east extended to the centerline of U.S. 20 which results in a variable width strip of land (47' x 120') between the centerline of U.S. 20 and the north right-of-way line of U.S. 20 that would remain in Pittsfield Township.

The policy adopted by the County Commissioners by Resolution No. 95-235 (copy attached) that if the annexation results in the same political subdivision on both sides of the road that the entire road should be included in the annexation. This would eliminate the potential of jurisdictional questions for emergency services that would be serving this area.

A separate annexation filing may be necessary to annex the strip of U.S. 20 (shown by hatch on the attached exhibit) to Oberlin to satisfy the County policy.

WHEREAS, said petition was filed as an Expedited Type 1 Annexation as authorized under R.C. 709.022 and the Board of Commissioners met on October 20, 2005, the next regular session following filing of the petition;

WHEREAS, Attorney Jon D. Clark said the petition was submitted as an Expedited 1 and requires no hearing.

WHEREAS, Assistant County Prosecutor Innes said this Expedited Type 1 annexation does not require a hearing. The petition has been signed by all owners, a map and legal description were received along with the agent and an annexation agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that upon review of the documents submitted, the following findings are made:

The Petition contains the signatures of all the property owners in the territory to be annexed.

- 1. The Petition contains an accurate legal description of the perimeter of the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 2. The Petition contains an accurate map or plat of the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 3. The Petition contains the name of the person acting as statutory agent for the petitioners.
- 4. Filed with the Petition is a list of all the tracts, lots or parcels in the territory proposed to be annexed together with all the tracts, lots or parcels located adjacent to the territory to be annexed or directly across the road, including the name and mailing address of each owner and the permanent parcel number of each parcel.
- 5. Filed with the Petition is an Annexation Agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Board of Trustees of Pittsfield Township.

## BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:

- I. Upon the findings that all of the conditions of annexation as contained in Revised Code Section 709.022 have been met, the Petition as presented is granted, incorporating the Annexation Agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Board of Trustees of Pittsfield Township.
- II. Herein the annex area will not be excluded from the Township
- III. The Clerk is directed to enter the resolution upon the journal of the Board and send a certified copy of the record (including all resolutions, the petition, the map and all other papers on file to the Clerk of the City of Oberlin.


