JORAIN COUNTY

AUDAN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE ELYRIA CITY LAW DIRECTOR TO PETITION COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO CHANGE THE LORAIN TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY LINES OF 226.13 ACRES OF LAND ANNEXED TO THE ELYRIA, BY ORDINANCE NO. 2008-72, AND DECLARING AN CITY OF EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Elyria City Law Director is hereby directed, on behalf of Elyria City Council to present to the Board of County Commissioners of Lorain County, a petition praying for such changes and extensions of the boundary lines of Ely Township as may be necessary to include those portions of other townships which have, by successive orders of the Board, been annexed to the City of Elyria, and make the boundary line of Ely Township co-extensive with the corporate limits of the City of Elyria. The boundary lines to be changed are those needed to conform to the City of Elyria's annexation as described in the attached Exhibit "A" and as depicted on its attached map. The change of boundary ines shall reflect the removal of the annexed territory from its present township and the inclusion of said territory to within the corporate limits of the City of Elyria and Ely Township. All this shall be done in accordance with and pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 503.07.

SECTION 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Ohio law.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to have the boundary of the described annexed territory conform to the boundary lines of Ely Township forthwith so that said property does not simultaneously remain within the
