WHEREAS, a Petition, Legal Description and Map were filed in the Board of Commissioners received by the Clerk on November 4, 2008 for the proposed Annexation of approximately 27.9260 acres in Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 08-791, adopted November 6, received and journalized said petition; and

WHEREAS, Letters were issued to Mark Stewart, Lorain County Auditor and Kenneth P. Carney, Lorain County Engineer asking for review and accuracy of the Petition and Map; and

WHEREAS, November 5, 2008 Lorain County Auditor certified the filing; and

WHEREAS, November 11, 2008 Lorain County Engineer submitted a letter as follows:

"This is in response to the Petition for the proposed annexation of 27.926 acres of land in Original Lot #16 of Pittsfield Township to the City of Oberlin. The petition was prepared by Erik Breunig acting agent for David L. Hanmer Trustee of the Merle Hanmer Trust sole owner of said parcel.

We have reviewed the description of the proposed parcel to be annexed to the drawing, which were prepared by Dale Haywood. We have found that there is no discrepancy between the description and the map. But the maps rendering of the city boundary is not shown property and needs to be corrected.

Also, the acreage shown on the map and in the description does not agree with County records. We do not believe this discrepancy has any consequence to this annexation.

The proposed parcel of land is adjacent and contiguous to the City of Oberlin. If there are any questions, please contact this office.

WHEREAS, November 12, 2008 a new map was received showing the corrected boundary area; and

WHEREAS, said petition was filed as an Expedited Type 1 Annexation as authorized under R.C. 709.022 and the Board of Commissioners received and filed the petition at a regular meeting on November 6, 2008 and the next regular session of November 13, 2008, a decision was rendered for the following petition;

WHEREAS, Agent Erik A. Breunig said the petition was submitted as an Expedited 1 along with the City of Oberlin Ordinance No. 06-71 AC CMS and annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, Assistant County Prosecutor Innes said this Expedited Type 1 annexation does not require a hearing. The petition has been signed by all owners, a map and legal description were received along with the agent and an annexation agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that upon review of the documents submitted, the following findings are made:

The Petition contains the signatures of all the property owners in the territory to be annexed.

- 1. The Petition contains an accurate legal description of the perimeter of the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 2. The Petition contains an accurate map or plat of the territory proposed to be annexed.
- 3. The Petition contains the name of the person acting as statutory agent for the petitioners.
- 4. Filed with the Petition is a list of all the tracts, lots or parcels in the territory proposed to be annexed together with all the tracts, lots or parcels located adjacent to the territory to be annexed or directly across the road, including the name and mailing address of each owner and the permanent parcel number of each parcel.
- 5. Filed with the Petition is an Annexation Agreement between the City of Oberlin and Board of Trustees of Pittsfield Township.

## BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:

- I. Upon the findings that all of the conditions of annexation as contained in Revised Code Section 709.022 have been met, the Petition as presented is granted, incorporating the Annexation Agreement between the City of Oberlin and the Board of Trustees of Pittsfield Township.
- II. Herein the annex area will not be excluded from the Township
- III. The Clerk is directed to enter the resolution upon the journal of the Board and send a certified copy of the record (including all resolutions, the petition, the map and all other papers on file to the Clerk of the City of Oberlin)
