AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY BETWEEN 10 TH AND 11TH 2.01.066. STREETS, HAMILTON AVENUE AND ALLEY WEST OF WASHINGTON AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition signed on August 17, 1982 by 100% of the owners of property abutting that portion of the alley south of 10th Street (16 feet wide) extending westerly from the westline of Sublot Number 20, of the David Wallace Tr. 1st Addition as recorded in Volume 5, Page 13 of Lorain County Record of Plats, 426.67 feet to the westline of Sublot Number 27 of the Doll-Braun Addition as recorded in Volume 8, Page 9 of the Lorain County Record of Plats, was clearly presented to City Council praying that said part of the alley be vacated; and

WHEREAS, City Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, ORC notice of pendency and prayer of said petition is not required.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I.

That the alley between 10th and 11st Streets, Hamilton Avenue and alley west of Washington Avenue, be the same is hereby vacated, subject however to the reservations that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas conduits, fire alarm system conduits, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary.

CLERM OF

ION II.

That each one half of the alley will revert to the respective owners on each side of said alley.

SECTION III.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
