SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 3. That one-half (1/2) of the width of said alley shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said Alley.

SECTION 2. That the petitioner, in consideration for the vacation of this Alley, shall, at his own expense, close the intersection of the Alley with Reid Avenue by constructing curb and sidewalk through the intersection, said work to be done under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer. This ordinance shall not take effect and be in force until satisfactorily completion of this work.

SECTION 1. That the Alley north of West 21st Street extending from Reid Avenue to 150 feet westerly, in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same here- by is vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or main- tain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephones and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of July, 1969, a petition signed by all the owners of property abutting on the Alley north of West 21st Street extending from Reid Avenue to 150 feet westerly, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley be vacated; and
