ORDINANCE NO. /28-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TO PROCEED WITH THE IMPROVEMENT OF PARK DRIVE FROM HIGHLAND PARK DRIVE TO 200' NORTH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ALL BEING ONE CONTINUOUS PROJECT IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO BY PAVING WITH PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE, GRADING, DRAINING, CURBING AND INSTALLING DRIVEWAY APRONS, TOGETHER WITH THE NECESSARY APPURTENANCES THERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That this Council determines to proceed with the improvement in the City of Lorain, Ohio, of Park Drive from Highland Park Drive to 200' North.

SECTION 2. That said street shall be improved in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No-21-H, passed on October 3, 2011, and with the plans, specifications, estimates, and profiles heretofore approved and now on file in the Office of the Clerk of this Council by paving with Portland cement concrete, grading, draining, curbing, and installing driveway aprons together with necessary appurtenances thereto.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> That all claims for damages resulting therefrom that have been legally filed shall be inquired into before commencement of the proposed improvement, and that the Law Director is hereby authorized and directed to institute legal proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into claims that have been so filed.

SECTION 4. That a portion of the cost provided in the above-mentioned Resolution of necessity be assessed in the manner and the number of installments provided in said Resolution and on the lots and lands described therein.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That the estimated assessments heretofore prepared are on file in the Office of the Clerk of this Council as appointed by Resolution No-21-11, adopted on-Oetober-3-20-11.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> The Clerk of this Council is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this ordinance to the County Auditor within fifteen (15) days after its passage.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> Subject to the provisions of Section 727.24 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Safety/Service Director of the City of Lorain is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of the improvement and execute a contract for said improvement with the lowest and best bidder according to law and the improvement shall be financed as provided in the Resolution of necessity.

<u>SECTION 8.</u> That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the nature of the emergency being the immediate preservation of the public welfare, health and safety of the citizens of the City and further reason being that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian and vehicular traffic and provide for the safety of the abutting property owners. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to City Council, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
