AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY LOCATED BETWEEN WEST 10TH STREET AND WEST 11TH STREET IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO, THAT:

- SECTION I. This Council finds that a petition signed by the owners of all the property abutting upon an alley located between West 10th Street and West 11th Street, beginning at a point on the west line of Reid Avenue and proceeding westerly 100 feet to the east line of a north-south alley which connects with West 10th Street and West 11th Street in the City of Lorain, Ohio, has been presented to this Council requesting that said alley between the points named by vacated.
- SECTION II. Council turther finds that there is good cause for such vacation of said alley as requested and that such vacation of said alley will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made.
- SECTION III. The alley located between West 10th Street and West 11th Street, beginning at a point on the west line of Reid Avenue and proceeding westerly 100 feet to the east line of a north-south alley which connects with West 10th Street and West 11th Street in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated.
- SECTION IV. The City Engineer is hereby instructed to prepare a vacation plat of said vacated alley and the Clerk of Council is instructed to endorse upon such plat the action of this Council in vacating such portion of said alley and cause said plat to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Lorain County, Ohio.
- SECTION V. The Clerk of Council is directed to notify the Auditor of Lorain County of the vacation, by sending to the County Auditar a copy of this ordinance.
- SECTION VI. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 3.21.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect after the earliest period allowed by law.
