ORDINANCE NO. 3144-95

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 51-95 AND CHANGING THE NAME OF MEADOW STREET AS IT APPEARS ON THE PLAT FOR MEADOW ACRES SUBDIVISION NO. 1 TO WHITE PINE STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the plat for Summer Hill Subdivision No. 2 contains the designation of White Pine Street, there is no need to change said designation as set forth in Ordinance No. 51-95, and therefore, said Ordinance should be repealed; and

WHEREAS, sublot numbers 13, 14 and 15, as shown on the original plat for Meadow Acres Subdivision No. 1, front on a street designated as Meadow Street, and pursuant to petition of the owners of said sublots and further in compliance of the recommendation of the Planning Commission to avoid confusion in the delivery of mail and other public and private services, it is necessary and desirable to change the name of Meadow Street to White Pine Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 51-95 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. That the street presently known as Meadow Street as shown on the plat for Meadow Acres Subdivision No. 1 containing sublot numbers 13, 14 and 15 recorded as Plat Vol. No. 42, Page No. 61 at the Lorain County Recorder's office is hereby changed from Meadow Street to White Pine Street.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to comply with recommendation of Planning Commission; therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage and approval by the Mayor.
