ORDINANCE NO. 156-80

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF GEORGETOWN COURT IN THE CITY OF AVON LAKE TO COVENTRY COURT.

WHEREAS, more than 60% of the property owners on Georgetown Court have petitioned that the name of said street be changed to Coventry Court, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission did on October 7, 1980 recommend to Council that the street name of Georgetown Court be changed to Coventry Court, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That a certain road located on the Westerly side of Avon Belden Road, immediately South of Redwood Boulevard in the City of Avon Lake, and heretofore referred to as Georgetown Court shall henceforth be, and it is hereby known as Coventry Court.

Section No. 2: That the City Engineer is authorized to have proper signs posted and City street maps noted accordingly.

Section No. 3: That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Avon Lake.
