

ORDINANCE NO. 16-04

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF
KING AVENUE IN THE NEW CENTURY
SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO
TO LIMESTONE DRIVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, currently King Avenue in the New Century Village Subdivision is not a continuation of the existing King Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the change in name of King Avenue in the New Century Subdivision to Limestone Drive will not be detrimental to the general interest of the public and is for good cause.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the name of King Avenue in the New Century Village Subdivision be changed and that the name of Limestone Drive be assigned to said street, upon passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, the emergency being the immediate need to change street names within the City, so as to avoid confusion, all for the health, safety and welfare of the City. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor providing it meets the statutory requirement for passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
