

ORDINANCE TO VACATE 171-87

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEYS NOT PREVIOUSLY VACATED SHOWN ON THE PLAT OF CENTRAL DIVISION AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 9, PAGE 5 OF THE LORAIN COUNTY RECORD OF PLATS.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council there exists good cause for the Vacating of the hereinafter described Alleys, and notice of the pendency and public hearing of such intention to vacate has been given as required by law by publication in the Lorain Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending NOVEMBER 19, 1987.

WHEREAS, Council upon a public hearing held DECEMBER 7, 1987, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Alleys not previously vacated shown on the Plat of Central Division as recorded in Volume 9, Page 5 of the Lorain County Record of Plats, be the same hereby are vacated, subject to the reservations that the City of Lorain, Ohio reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said Alleys whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That one half (1/2) of the width of said Alleys shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said Alleys.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
