

ORDINANCE NO. 18-79

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE REID AVENUE EXTENDING FROM FOURTH STREET TO FIFTH STREET, IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that there is good cause for vacating, under Section 723.15, Ohio Revised Code, Reid Avenue, extending from 4th Street to Fifth Street, and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain Planning Commission met on January 24, 1979 and has recommended said street be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

- SECTION 1. That Reid Avenue, extending from Fourth Street to Fifth Street, in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated, subject however, to the reservations that the City of Lorain, Ohio reserves to itself and others, easement rights within the limits of Reid Avenue, so vacated, to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, telephone conduits, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines, and other similar facilities under, on, or above said street whenever deemed necessary, by the City of Lorain.
- SECTION 2. That one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the width of said street shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said street.
- SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Lorain and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds ($\frac{2}{3}$) of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

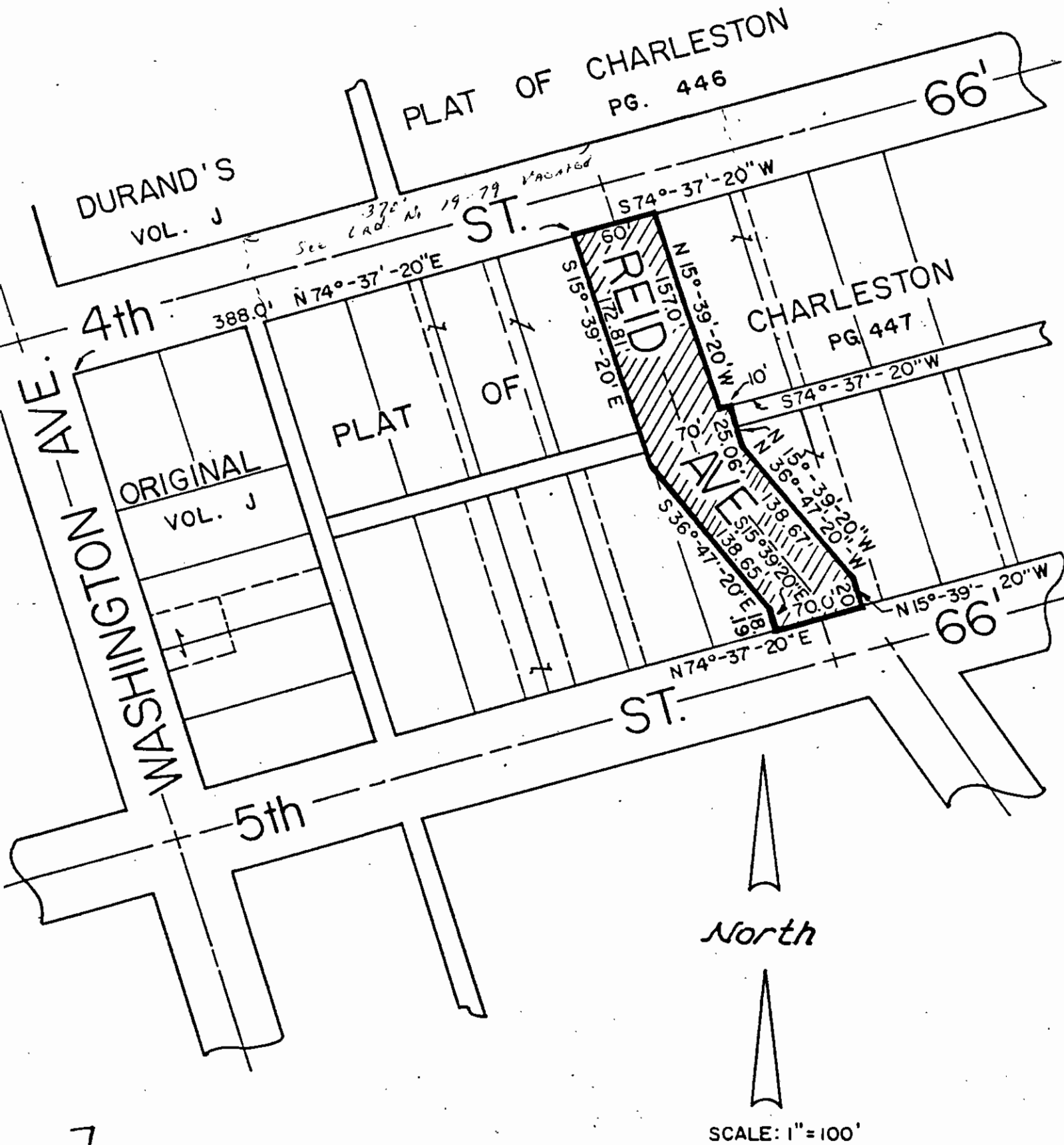
