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AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF BARNES STREET (50' WIDE) FROM THE EASTLINE OF SURF ROAD EASTERLY ABOUT 108.25 FEET TO THE WESTLINE OF AN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by 100% of the owners of property abutting a portion of Barnes Street 50 feet wide, extending from the eastline of Surf Road easterly about 108.25 feet to the westline of an alley, was duly presented to Council praying that said portion of the street be vacated; and

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of July, 1981, the Lorain City Planning Commission approved said vacation; and

WHEREAS, City Council, upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06 Ohio Revised Code, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That a portion of Barnes Street (50' wide) extending from the eastline of Surf Road easterly about 108.25 feet to the westline of an alley in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same is hereby vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas and electric conduits, fire alarm system conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said street whenever deemed necessary.

SECTION 2. That one-half ( ) of the width of said Alley shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said Alley.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
