AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY CONVEYED TO THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO FOR PARK PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO.

SECTION 1. That the following described real estate conveyed by Deed executed by Northern Union Holdings Corporation (a corporation incorporated under the laws of the State of Ohio), to the City of Lorain, Ohio for park purposes, be accepted and dedicated to public use:

A parcel of land situated in the Township of Black River, Tract No. 2, and Original Lot No. 12;

Beginning at the Southeasterly corner of Lot No. 67, known as Park Area as shown on the recorded plat of Kneirim Drive Homes, as recorded in Plat Volume 14 of Maps, Pages 26 and 27 of Lorain County Records; thence from said place of beginning South 1° 05' 00" West along the Easterly line of Kneirim Drive Homes Vacated, a distance of 302.14 feet to a point; thence North 89° 02' 30" West, a distance of 578.18 feet to the Westerly line of Kneirim Drive Homes Vacated, thence North 0° 57' 30" East a distance of 360.69 feet to a point at the Southwesterly corner of the now existing Kneirim Drive Homes, thence South 89° 02' 30" East, a distance of 484.01 feet to an angle, thence South 57° 21' East, a distance of 111.50 feet to the place of beginning and containing within said bounds 4.72 acres of land, be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
