ORDINANCE NUMBER 182-72

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PLAT OF HICKORY HILL
SUBDIVISION NUMBER TWO TO THE CITY OF LORAIN,
OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain,
State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the plat of Hickory Hill Subdivision Number Two (Lots
Numbered 63 through 103 inclusive) in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and
the same is hereby approved. The Streets shown thereon were accepted
on the Hickory Hill Street Dedication Plat and by Ordinance Number 185-
67 passed 6 November 1967.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
members elected or appointed to Council it shall take effect and be in
force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
it shall take effect
and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
