ORDINANCE NO. 1836 -83

AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALDEN AVENUE FROM DYKE ROAD EAST TO ITS EASTERLY TERMINUS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Alden Avenue from Dyke Road east to its easterly terminus, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: That the portion of the street hereby vacated shall revert to the abutting property owners in equal amounts, subject to access rights for all properties abutting the street herein vacated.

SECTION 3: That the Engineer be and he is hereby authorized to prepare and submit necessary data required to effect the transfer to the Engineer, Auditor and Recorder of Lorain County, Ohio.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
