That Herrick Court from the westline of South Broadway westerly to the west terminus, be the same is hereby vacated, subject however, that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas conduits, electric conduits, fire alarm system conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under or above said street whenever deemed necessary.
