Be it resolved by the Council of the village of
Wellington, County of Lorain and state of Ohio:

Sec-1. - That the plat of the extension of
Erie street westerly across the right-of-way of
the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railway Co, premises
of the Steeling Foundry Company and the
Granite Improvement Co, heretofore deeded by
quit-claim deed to said village of Wellington,
Ohio, be and the same is hereby accepted,
and the clerk is hereby authorized and directed
to endorse said acceptance upon said plat
and cause the same to be recorded in the
Book of Plats in the Recorder's Office of said
County, and to draw his warrant for the
payment of the same.
