ORDINANCE NO. 198-73

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PORTIONS OF
GROVELAND DRIVE IN THE CITY OF AVON
LAKE

WHEREAS, the Avon Lake Public Schools by and through the Board of Education have petitioned council that portions of Groveland Drive be vacated and that portions requested to be vacated is bounded and abuts parcels owned by the Avon Lake Public Schools, and

WHEREAS, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation as prayed for and that such will not be detrimental to the general interest, safety and welfare and that said vacation ought to be made, now therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON LAKE,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section No. 1: That Groveland Drive from Avon-Belden Road, also known as Center Road, east for a distance of 1596.60 ft. to the westerly line of the intersection of Lewis Avenue and Groveland Drive be and the same is hereby vacated reserving and excepting unto the City of Avon Lake an easement within said right of way for water, sanitary and storm sewer facilities.

Section No. 2: That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
