


Ordinance No. 199-99 (Con't)


that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to accept improvements pursuant to Avon Codified Ordinances prior to issuance of Building Permits in the Subdivision; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


