ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 148

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PETITION OF MAYNARD IL PANDY AND KATHERINE M. PANDY, FOR ANNEXATION TO TEE CITY OF ELYRIA OF 3.02 ACRES OF LAND, SITUATED IN ELYRIA TOWNSHIP. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA. STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the petition of Maynard K. Pandy and Katherine M. Paney. approved by the Lorain County Commissioners under Resolution 00-354 and received by the Clerk of Council's office on May 25, 2000 for the annexation to the Cry of Engize of 3.02 acres of land, situated in Elyria Township, and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein, be and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Elyzatizatize land described in Exhibit "A" shall be a part of Ward 2 of the City.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of Council shall make three (3) comes containing the petition, the map or plat accompany the Petition, a transcript of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners, and resolutions and ordinances in relation to the amexation, with a certificate to each copy that is correct. The other copy shall be forwarded by tibe Auditor or Clerk to the Secretary of State.

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To: Board of County Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio

We, the undersigned, being competent adult individuals seized of a freehold estate in the within described territory, and being a majority of the owners of the real estate as hereinafter more fully described, do hereby petition for the annexation of said territory to the City of Elyria, Lorain County, Onic, to wit;

Situated in the Township of Elyria, County of Lorain and State of Ohio. Being known as parts of Original Lots Nos. 14 and 16 in the Brace Tract of Elyria Township and more definitely described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Griswold Road and the centerline of Leona Street as shown by the plat of Cassell Industrial Park Phase 1 as recorded in Volume 35, Pages 3-5 of Lorain County Plat Records;

Thence westerly in the centerline of Griswolf Road, a distance of 109.48 feet to the southwesterly corner of said Phase 1 and the southeasterly corner of land now or formerly owned by Theodore P. Dowdell;

Thence northerly in the westerly line of Cassell Industrial Park Phase 1 and in Dowdell's easterly line, a distance of about 293 feet to Dowdell's northeasterly corner, an angle point in the existing corporation line of the City of Elyria, and a point in the centerline of existing ditch; said point is the principal place of beginning;

Pandy;

Thence easterly in Dowdell's northerly line and in the existing corporation line of the City of Elyria, a distance of about 102.27 feet to the principal place of beginning:


