ORDINANCE NO. 2004- 14/

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PETITION OF JOYCE MARIE CLARK, ET AL, FOR ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF ELYRIA FOR 75.45 ACRES OF LAND, SITUATED IN EATON TOWNSHIP.

BE ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to ORC Section 709.04, the petition of Joyce Marie Clark, et al, approved by the Lorain County Commissioners under Resolution 04-422 and received by the Clerk of Elyria City Council's office on July 14, 2004, for the annexation to the City of Elyria of 75.45 acres of land, situated in Eaton Township, and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein, be and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Elyria that the land described in Exhibit "A" shall be a part of Ward 3 of the City.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of Elyria City Council (CLERK) shall make three (3) copies containing the petition, the map or plat accompanying the Petition, a transcript of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners, and resolutions and ordinances in relation to the annexation, with a certificate to each copy that is correct. Such certificate shall be signed by the CLERK in his official capacity, and shall be authenticated by the seal of the municipal corporation, if there is any. The CLERK shall forthwith deliver one such copy to the County Auditor and one such copy to the County Recorder, who shall make a record thereof in the proper book of records and preserve it. The other copy shall be forwarded by the CLERK to the Secretary of State.



Volume 852, Page 531 of Lorain County Deed Records;

COURSE 5: Thence N 89°-04'-44" W along the southerly line of said land conveyed to Stanko et al, and along the northerly line of said land conveyed to Krecic, a distance of 643.86 feet to a capped 5/8" iron pin set at its intersection with the easterly line of said land conveyed to The Mary Jane Blakeslee Living Trust; said point also being on the said easterly line of said Original Eaton Township Lot Number 91;

COURSE 6: Thence S 1°-03′-39″ W along the said easterly line of land conveyed to The Mary Jane Blakeslee Living Trust, and along the said easterly line of said Original Eaton Township Lot Number 91, and passing through the said northerly sideline of Chestnut Ridge Road at 873.31 feet, a total distance of 906.32 feet to the place of beginning, but subject to all legal highways, and containing 76.772 acres of land according to a survey by Capital Survey Company dated October, 2003, by Ralph M. Gugar, Registered Surveyor No. 7949.
