VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON ORDINANCE NO. 2023 - 20

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING A SEGMENT OF CLAY STREET. AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE

Whereas, the Village Council has received a Petition signed by one or more persons owning lot(s) in the immediate vicinity of Clay Street, seeking to have the name of a segment of that street changed; and

Whereas, this Council has scheduled a public hearing on that petition and is now satisfied that there is good cause for changing the name of a segment of Clay Street; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest; and that the name change should be made; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That this Council now declares that the segment of Clay Street, which runs east and west beginning at Barker Street up to the existing railroad right-of-way owned by CSX Transportation, Inc. (Parcel Number: 1800021500001), shall be renamed as: Cloud Street; and that the remaining western portion of Clay Street shall remain named as Clay Street.
- Section 2. That the Clerk of this Council shall cause a certified copy of this Ordinance to be recorded with the Lorain County Recorder; that the Village Manager shall cause appropriate signage to be affixed to the segment of the Street to indicate this change; and that the Village Manager is authorized to execute such documents, cause this change to be noted in the Village Zoning Map, and notify such other governmental agencies as may be necessary to effectuate this change.
- The Council finds and determines that all formal actions relating to the Section 3. adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; that the deliberations of this Council and its Committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements, including the requirements of Section 121.22 off the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary for this measure to become official and operational at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


