

ORDINANCE NO. 2125

Accepting and approving Application for Annexation for contiguous territory.

WHEREAS, Council of the City of Lorain by Ordinance Number 2076 passed the 15 day of October 1917, duly authorized C. E. Van Deusen, as Solicitor of said City, to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect the annexation of the property described in said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of February, 1918, due notice of which date being properly posted as required by law, the County Commissioners passed a Resolution granting the annexation as prayed for in the Petition filed on behalf of the City of Lorain; and

WHEREAS, under date of February 11th, 1918, said County Commissioners caused to be filed with the Clerk of Council a complete transcript of proceedings had before said County Commissioners in reference to such annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1.

That the application of the City of Lorain authorized by Ordinance Number 2076 for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Lorain and contiguous and adjacent to the City of Lorain, to-wit:

Beginning in the center line of the Root Road and Colorado Avenue; thence westerly along the center line of Colorado Avenue to the west line of Original Lot No. 55, Sheffield Township; thence northerly along the West line of Original Lots Nos. 55 and 48, Sheffield Township, to the north right of way line of the L. E. & P. R. R. Company; thence easterly along the north right of way line of the L. E. & P. R. R. Company to the west line of Original Lot No. 46, Sheffield Township, thence northerly along the west line of Original Lot No. 46, Sheffield Township, to the North line of the East Haven Sub-division; thence easterly along the north line of the East Haven Sub-division, and this line extended to a point 330 feet east of the center line of the Root Road; thence southerly in a line parallel with the center line of the Root Road and 330 feet distant therefrom

to the north bank of Black River; thence westerly along the north bank of Black River to a point where the center line of the Root Road, extended southerly, intersects the north bank of Black River; thence northerly along the extension of the center line of the Root Road to the place of beginning;

an accurate map of which territory, together with the Petition for its Annexation, as filed by the City Solicitor, duly authorized, and other papers relating thereto and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto now being on file with the Clerk of the Council of said City; be and the same is hereby approved and accepted.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
