AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF ALL PRO ATHLETIC AVENUE TO SILVER MAPLE WAY IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO

WHERAS, there exists in the City of Lorain, Ohio a street known as All Pro Athletic Avenue, as more fully shown in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference; and,

WHEREAS, All Pro Athletic Avenue is no longer limited to use by the persons conducting activities with the All Pro Athletic Center, a business located on All Pro Athletic Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 723.04, a property owner in the municipal corporation has petitioned the legislative authority of the City of Lorain, to change the name of All Pro Athletic Avenue to Silver Maple Way, as more fully shown in Exhibit B, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference; and,

WHEREAS, good cause exists to change the name of the street as additional uses of the land abutting All Pro Athletic Avenue have arisen.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the name of All Pro Athletic Avenue be and is hereby changed and that the name of Silver Maple Way shall be and is hereby assigned to said street.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


