ORDINANCE NO. 235

ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ENTIRE ALLEY RUNNING EAST AND WEST BETWEEN STATE STREET AND EAST AVENUE AND PARALLEL WITH AND BETWEEN SOUTH STREET AND MIDDLE STREET, IN THE VILLAGE OF ROCHESTER, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO.

Whereas, on the 7th day of November 1949, it was determined by the Council of this Village that ~~there was~~ there is good cause for vacating the entire alley which runs East and West between State Street and East Avenue and runs parallel with and lies between South Street and Middle Street, all in the Village of Rochester, Lorain County, Ohio. And it was further determined by this Council that the vacation of this alley would not be detrimental to the interest of the Village of Rochester; and,

Whereas, notice of the intention of this Council to vacate said alley has been given by law by posting notices of its intention to act on the vacation of said alley by having the Clerk post notices of said action in three public places within the corporation of the Village of Rochester for a period of six(6) weeks, beginning September 21, 1949; an ending December 2, 1949.

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied there is good cause for said vacation of said alley and that it will not be detrimental to the Village interest and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Rochester, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: THAT SAID ALLEY BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY VACATED.

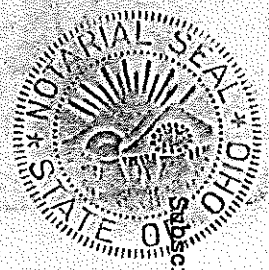
SECTION 2: THAT THIS ORDINANCE BE AND REMAIN IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE
