SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 2. That one-half (1/2) of the width of said street shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said street.

SECTION 1. That East 43rd Street extending from Maple Road to the Alley West of Maple Road, in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same hereby its vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said street whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, notice of the petition and prayer of said petition is not required, and

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of September, 1974, a petition signed by all the owners of property abutting on East 43rd Street extending from Maple Road to the Alley West of Maple Road, was duly presented to Council, praying that said street be vacated, and
