

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEY BETWEEN WEST 24th STREET AND WEST 25th STREET WEST OF OAKDALE AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO.

WHEREAS, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO is of the opinion that there is good cause for vacating the Alley between West 24th Street and West 25th Street west of Oakdale Avenue without a petition.

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation of said Alley and that said Alley is no longer needed for municipal purposes and should be vacated:

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Alley between West 24th Street and West 25th Street west of Oakdale Avenue in the City of Lorain, Ohio be and the same hereby is vacated, subject, however, to the reservations that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the width of said alley shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said alley.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
