

ORDINANCE NO.

25-14

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REVISED FINAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR MORNINGSIDE SUBDIVISION 3 IN MARTINS RUN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Lorain City Planning Commission, at their meeting February 5th 2014, reviewed and recommended that the final revised development plan for Morningside Subdivision 3 in Martins Run be approved.

WHEREAS, said recommendation for approval was transmitted to Lorain City Council on February 7, 2014, in accordance with Section 1157.18 of the Lorain Codified Ordinances.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Lorain Codified Ordinance Section 1157.19, within sixty (60) days after receipt of the final recommendations of the Planning Commission, Lorain City Council shall, by ordinance, either approve or disapprove the final development plan as presented.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I.

That Lorain City Council hereby approves the revised final development Plan as recommended by the Lorain Planning Commission for Subdivision 3 of Morningside in Martins Run, which is located within a R-PUD Planned Unit Development District, a copy of said plan being attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A" and fully incorporated herein.

SECTION II.

That Lorain City Council hereby directs the Building Inspector to issue building permits only in accordance with this approved final development plan.

SECTION III.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberation of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V.

Except as otherwise provided herein, this Ordinance shall be in force from and after the earliest date provided by statute.

SECTION VI.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Lorain. The reason for such necessity is that the Agreement authorized herein will be a great benefit to the municipality and the delay of this project could adversely affect the developer. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage and approval of the Mayor, providing it meets the statutory requirements for passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
