## ORDINANCE NO. 27-61

AN ORDINANCE VACATING TENNYSON AVENUE BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI WITHIN THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD LAKE, OHIO.

- WHEREAS, a Petition by persons owning Lots in the immediate vicinity of that portion of Tennyson Avenue hereinafter described was duly presented to Council praying that said Avenue between the points named be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said Petition has been given as required by law, and
- WHEREAS, the Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general welfare, and ought to be made,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following portion of Tennyson Avenue located within the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated:

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of Original Sheffield Township Lot No. 42 and extending to the extreme Easterly boundary line of property owned by Phillip Alessandro as it would be extended Southerly.

- Section 2. That, however, the City hereby reserves, and the abutting property owners hereby take their respective shares in the vacated portion of Tennyson Avenue, subject to any easements for public utilities and natural or artificial water courses that may exist on said vacated portion of Tennyson Avenue.
- Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




