AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY BETWEEN W. 30th STREET
AND W. 31st STREET EXTENDING FROM REID AVENUE TO THE
ALLEY EAST OF LEXINGTON AVENUE.

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of March, 1969, a petition signed by all the owners of property abutting on the Alley between W. 30th Street and W. 31st Street extending from Reid Avenue to the alley east of Lexington Avenue, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley be vacated, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Alley between W. 30th Street and W. 31st Street extending from Reid Avenue to the alley east of Lexington Avenue, in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same hereby is vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the width of said alley shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said Alley.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
