ORDINANCE TO VACATE CERTAIN UNNAMED ALLEYS

ORDINANCE NO. 30

To vacate a certain unnamed alley lying between Lexington Avenue and Long Avenue and extending Northerly from Fifteenth Street to the East and West Alley lying between Fourteenth and Fifteenth Streets in the City of Lorain, State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, on the fifteenth day of June, 1925, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of a certain unnamed alley lying between Lexington Avenue and Long Avenue and extending Northerly from Fifteenth Street to the East and West Alley lying between Fourteenth and Fifteenth Streets, was duly presented to council praying that said certain unnamed alley, between the points named, he vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in times Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending the twenty sixth day of August, 1925; and,

WHEREAS? council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNDIL, of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio

SECTION 1.

That a certain unnamed alley lying between Lexington Avenue and Long Avenue and extending Northerly from Fifteenth Street to the East and West Alley lying between Fourteenth and Fifteenth Streets in the City of Lorain, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2.

That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
