ORDINANCE NO. 5/8

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF GROVE STREET, BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF BARNES AND GROVE STREETS, IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition signed by 100% of the owners of property abutting Grove and Barnes Streets, Lorain, Ohio, was duly presented to Council praying that said portion of the street be vacated; and

WHEREAS, City Council, upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, under the provision of Section 723.01 Ohio Revised Code, notice of pendency and prayer of said petition is not required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I.

That a portion of Grove Street, (50 feet wide), as shown on the Plat of Erie Beach Company Allotment as recorded in Volume II. Page 8 of Lorain County Record of Plats beginning at the intersection of the northline of Barnes Street (50 feet wide), and the westline of Grove Street, a distance of 114.78 feet to the southline of U.S. Route 6, thence northeasterly in the southline of U.S. Route 6 a distance of 52.94 feet to the intersection of the southline of U.S. Route θ and the eastline of Grove Street, thence southerly in the eastline of Grove Street, a distance of 132.19 feet to the northline of Barnes Street, thence westerly in the northline of Barnes Street, a distance of 50.00 feet to the principal place of beginning, be the same is hereby vacated, subject however, that the City of Lorain, Ohio reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas conduits, electric conduits, fire alarm system conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under or above said street whenever deemed necessary.

SECTION II.

That it is agreed that each one-half of the street will revert to the respective abutting owners on each side of said street.

SECTION III.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
