ORDINANCE NO. 1117

ORDINANCE TO VACATE ALLEY BETWEEN ALLEY WEST OF ERIC AVENUE AND LEXINGTON AVENUE AND BETWEEN 25TH ST. AND 26TH ST.; ALLEY EXTENDING EASTWARD FROM ASHLAND AVENUE, BETWEEN 19TH ST. AND 20TH ST.; ALLEY EXTENDING FROM ALLEY EAST OF REID AVENUE TO ALLEY WEST OF BROADWAY AND BETWEEN 27TH ST. AND 28TH ST.; ALLEY BETWEEN ALLEY EAST OF HAMILTON AVENUE AND ALLEY WEST OF WASHINGTON AVENUE AND BETWEEN 18TH ST. AND 19TH ST.; ALLEY EXTENDING EASTWARD FROM ASHLAND AVENUE AND BETWEEN 20TH ST. AND 21ST ST.; ALLEY EXTENDING EASTWARD FROM REID AVENUE BETWEEN WEST 30TH ST. AND WEST 31ST ST.; ALLEY EXTENDING WESTWARD FROM ALLEY WEST OF BROADWAY TO SCHOOL GROUNDS, BETWEEN WEST 30TH ST. AND WEST 31ST ST.; ALLEY BETWEEN 21ST ST. AND 22ND ST. AND BETWEEN OAKDALE AVENUE AND BEECH AVENUE; ALLEY BETWEEN 26TH ST. AND 27TH ST. FROM ALLEY EAST OF REID AVENUE TO ALLEY WEST OF BROADWAY.

WHEREAS, petitions by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Alley between Alley West of Reid Avenue and Lexington Avenue and between 25th St and 26th St.; Alley extending eastward from Ashland Avenue, between 19th St. and 20th St.; Alley extending from Alley east of Reid Avenue to Alley west of Broadway and between 27th St. and 28th St.; Alley between Alley east of Hamilton Avenue and Alley west of Washington Avenue and between 18th St. and 19th St.; Alley extending eastward from Ashland Avenue and between 20th St. and 21st St.; Alley extending westward from Alley west of Broadway to School grounds, between West 30th St. and West 31st St.; Alley between 21st St. and 22nd St. and between Oakdale Avenue and Beech Avenue; Alley between 26th St. and 27th Street from Alley east of Reid Avenue to alley west of Broadway, were duly presented to Council praying that said streets, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petitions have been given as required by law, by publication in The Lorain Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending August 10th, 1932; and,

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I

That Alley between Alley West of Reid Avenue and Lexington Avenue and between 25th St. and 26th St.; Alley extending eastward from Ashland Avenue, between 19th St. and 20th St.; Alley extending from Alley east of Reid Avenue to alley west of Broadway and between 27th St. and 28th St.; Alley between Alley east of Hamilton Avenue and Alley west of Washington Avenue and between 18th St. and 19th St.; Alley extending eastward from Ashland Avenue and between 20th St. and 21st St.; Alley extending eastward from Reid Avenue between West 30th St. and West 31st St.; Alley extending westward from Alley west of Broadway to School grounds, between West 30th St. and West 31st St.; Alley between 21st Street and 22nd St. and between Oakdale Avenue and Beech Avenue; Alley between 26th St. and 27th St. from Alley east of Reid Avenue to alley west of Broadway, be and the same are hereby vacated.

SECTION II

That the City of Lorain, State of Ohio, expressly reserves to itself and assigns an easement in, to through and over the above described premises, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and repairing all necessary or desired electric light and power lines, telephone electric signal lines, water and sewer lines;
