

ORDINANCE NO. 4507

To vacate an alley south of West 23rd Street between Kelly Place and Lexington Avenue, in the City of Lorain, Ohio.

WHEREAS, a petition by persons on Lots in the immediate vicinity of the alley south of West 23rd Street between Kelly Place and Lexington Avenue, Lorain, Ohio, was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley between the points named, be vacated; And there is filed with Council, written consent of such vacation by all of the owners of property abutting the alley aforesaid proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That the alley south of West 23rd Street between Kelly Place and Lexington Avenue in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2.

That the City of Lorain, State of Ohio, expressly reserves to itself and assigns an easement in, to, through and over the above described premises, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and repairing all necessary or desired electric light and power lines, telephone or electrical signal lines, water and sewer lines, and other Public Utility uses.

SECTION 3.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
