WHEREAS, on the 19th day of September, 1938, a petition by persons owning Lots in the immediate vacinity of the alley between Brownell Avenue and Ashland Avenue from West 13th Street to West 14th Street, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley between the points named be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been published in The Lorain Journal and Times Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation for six consecutive weeks ending November 18, 1938; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:
SECTION 1. That the alley between Brownell Avenue and Ashland Avenue from West 13th Street to
West 14th Street, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


