ORDINANCE NO. 4930  
An Ordinance to vacate an alley from Beech Avenue to Washington Avenue, between West 22nd Street and West 23rd Street.

Whereas, on the 16-day of Dec. 1941, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of an alley from Beech Avenue to Washington Avenue, between West 22nd Street and West 23rd Street, was duly presented to council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in The Lorain Journal and The Lorain Times Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lorain, for six consecutive weeks ending Jan. 25, 1941, 1941; and

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an alley from Beech Avenue to Washington Avenue, between West 22nd Street and West 23rd Street, be and the same is hereby vacated, reserving to City right of ingress & egress for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
