ORDINANCE NO. 4095

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEY RUNNING NORTH FROM DILWORTH STREET TO THE REAR OF THE LOTS FRONTING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF DILWORTH STREET AND THENCE EASTERLY TO HARWOOD STREET AND TO VACATE THE ALLEY RUNNING SOUTH FROM DILWORTH STREET TO THE REAR OF THE LOTS FRONTING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF DILWORTH AND THENCE EASTERLY TO HARWOOD STREET IN THE CITY OF ELYRIA, OHIO.

WHEREAS, there has been presented to Council a petition by the owners of lots in the vicinity of the alleys at the rear of the lots fronting on the north and south sides of Dilworth Street in the City of Elyria requesting that said alleys be vacated; and

WHEREAS, notice of this request has been given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, this Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the alley running north from Dilworth Street to the rear of the lots fronting on the northerly side of Dilworth Street and then easterly to Harwood Street in the City of Elyria, Ohio, and that the alley running south from Dilworth Street to the rear of the lots fronting on the southerly side of Dilworth Street and thence easterly to Harwood Street in the City of Elyria, Ohio, be and the same are hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
