

ORDINANCE NO. 5461

An Ordinance to vacate certain alleys hereinafter set forth more particularly, within the City of Lorain, Ohio.

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of April, 1945, The City Council of the City of Lorain, Ohio, gave notice to persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of certain alleys hereafter more particularly described; said notice was published in The Lorain Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in a corporation for six consecutive weeks, ending May 12, 1945; and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation of said alleys, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the following alleys from the points named to the termini named, to-wit:

- Alley West of Pennsylvania Avenue from Wilson Street to Eastlawn Street,
- Alley West of New York Avenue from Wilson Street to Eastlawn Street,
- Alley West of New Mexico Avenue from Wilson Street to Eastlawn Street
- Alley West of Iowa Avenue from "E" Street to Alley South of East Erie Avenue,
- Alley South of 19th Street from Alley West of Long Avenue to Alley East of Washington Avenue,
- Alley South of 18th Street from Alley West of Hamilton Avenue to Alley East of Oberlin Avenue,
- Alley South of 19th Street from Ashland Avenue to Pole Avenue,
- Alley South of 20th Street from Ashland Avenue to Pole Avenue,
- Alley south of 23rd Street from Oberlin Avenue to Ashland Avenue,
- Alley East of Lexington Avenue from West 30th Street to South line of Alley North of West 31st Street,
- Alley South of East 33rd Street from Alley East of Elyria Avenue to Dallas Avenue,

be and the same are hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
